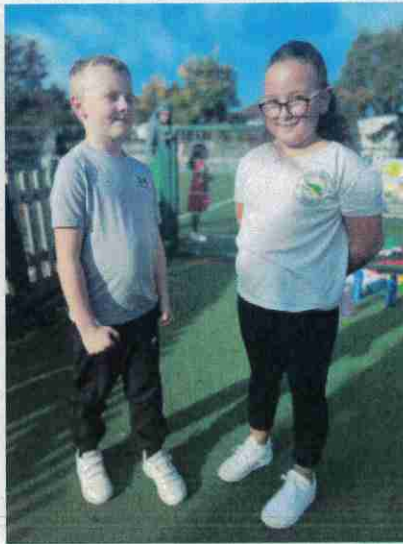

School Uniform Policy

Our school's uniform is dark green, and we require children to wear a uniform every day. The pictures below demonstrate what we expect all children at the school to wear.

The middle picture illustrates our school PE kit.



Uniform items

- A plain white top or polo shirt.
- A green jumper (with a logo or without).
- Black or grey trousers, shorts* or skirt, or
- Black or grey school pinafore dress, or
- A green gingham-style summer dress*
- A plain-coloured hijab (optional)

PE Kit:

- A plain white or grey top, or our Church Cowley Tigermoths t-shirt (only available from the school office)
- Black or grey shorts* or jogging trousers
- Appropriate trainers.

* Uniform required only at certain times of the year, for example, in summer

Jewellery

At school we do not permit dangly or hoop earrings. Children may wear stud style earrings only. This is for health and safety reasons.

All earrings must be removed for any swimming lessons.

Necklaces, rings and bracelets must not be worn at school.

No 'smart' watches to be worn.

Where can I buy a uniform?

You can buy jumpers and tops with the school logo at MyClothing.

We do not require uniforms to have logos, so if you want to buy plain green jumpers and plain white tops from other shops, that is fine. You can find suitable school uniforms at **Tesco**, **Sainsbury's** and **Asda**, as well as many online stores.

At certain times of the year our PSA do sell pre-loved items.
